There was a point where everything bent down and it took something from me something I can't quite explain and I always wondered if it would come back

.

I've tried so hard to explain in words what it meant to me how it felt to me but maybe it's not meant to be explained maybe it's not meant to be marked down in words or scrawled out on a piece of paper until then, I quess I'll just lie here and wait

Queerness here is not a flag, not a definition. it is a process. a pulse. a presence. and you are invited to witness it, just as it is.

Thorchia' is a solo performance exploring the complexities of pansexual identity through movement, hair and mark-making. This work is shaped by the feeling of never quite belonging – the feeling of being too straight for queer spaces, too queer for straight ones. Through scored improvisation and painting with hair on paper, the body becomes both medium and message. What remains is not only a trace of motion, but a visceral archive of identity-in-process.
